

Crochet baby hexagon jacket: Free pattern and Tutorial

Crochet baby hexagon jacket



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This time I want to bring you this free crochet pattern of the hexagon jacket that I made for my daughter Micaela who will be born in January of next year.

This jacket is made with two hexagons that folded in half become the two halves of the jacket.

Once the two halves are seamed together, we add the collar and cuffs.

This pattern can be found on the web in several languages ??as “saquito hexagonal o en hexágono”, “chompita hexagonal”, “chompa en hexágono”, “casaquinho hexágonos”, “hexagon jacket” or “hexagon sweater”. As you can see, this is a very popular pattern that allows you a lot of color combinations.

It is an ideal project for beginners and those who don't like the idea of crocheting sleeves separately.

To increase the size of the jacket make bigger hexagons by adding rows.

Here is the PATTERN:

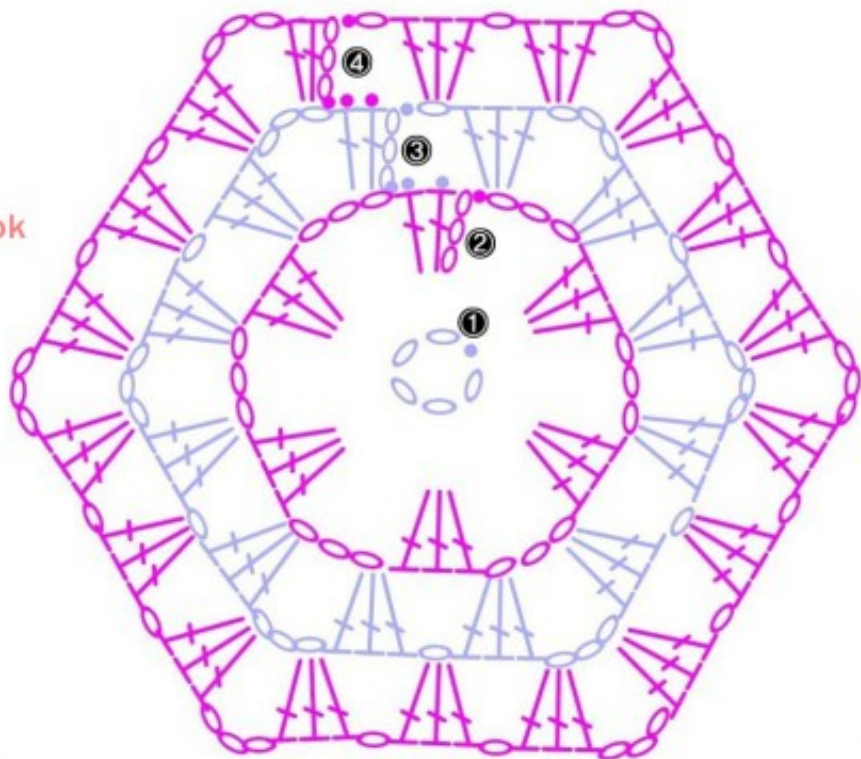
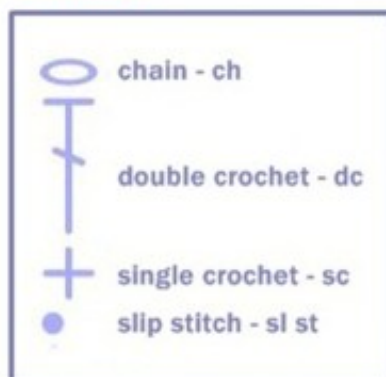


Size: 0 to 3 months

Materials used:

- *2.50 oz of cotton yarn
- *US - E/4 mm crochet hook
- *3 buttons

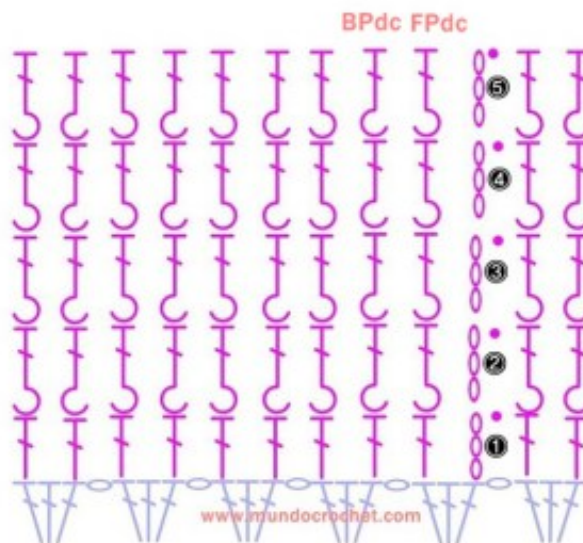
Stitches:

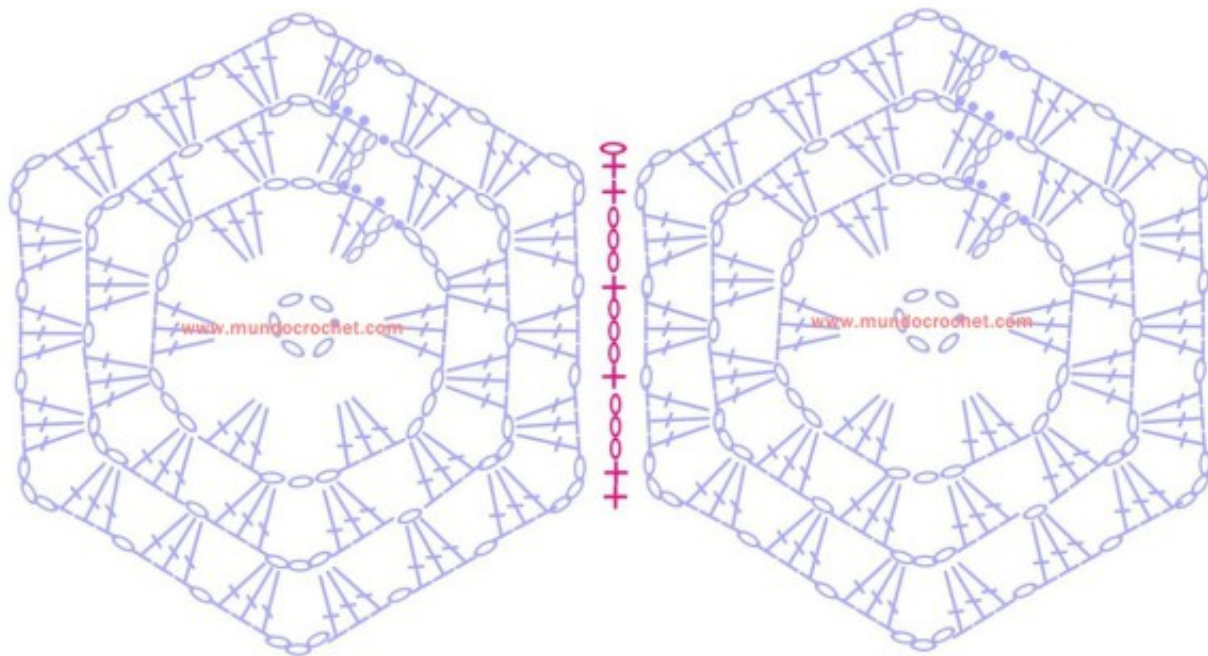

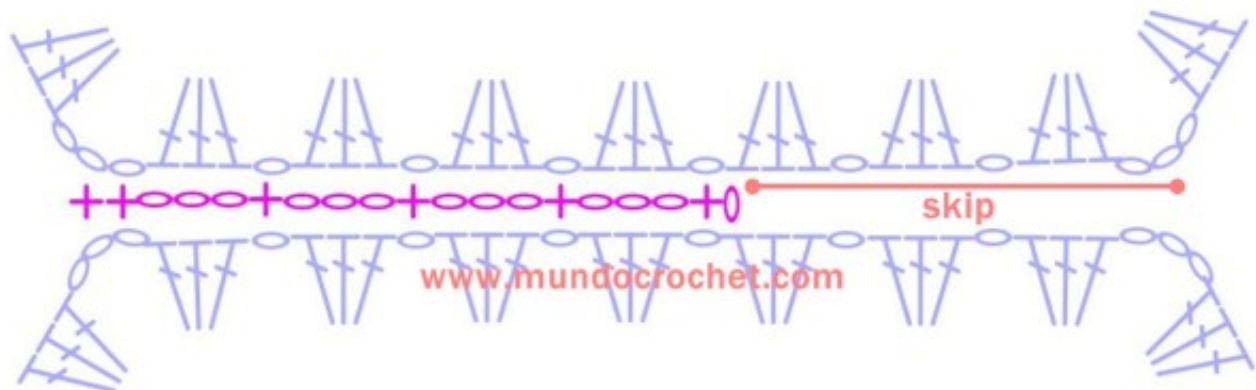
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Crochet baby hexagon jacket: Pattern

Here is the TUTORIAL:

(1) Ch 5, sl st to form a ring.



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(2) Ch 3 (counts as 1st dc).



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(3) 2 dc inside ring.

*Ch 3, 3 dc in ring.
Repeat from * 4 more times. Ch 3.
Join with sl st to top of 3rd ch of
beginning ch3.
(6 groups of 3 dcs, 3 ch).



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(5)

Sl st to ch 3 space. Ch 3, 2 dc in same space. Ch 3, 3 dc in same space.

*Ch 1, (3 dc, ch 3, 3 dc) in next ch 3 space. Repeat from * 4 more times. Ch 1, join with sl st to top of beginning ch 3.

(6 groups of (3 dc, ch 3, 3 dc), 6 ch 1 spaces).

Sl st to ch 2 space. Ch 3, 2 dc in same space. Ch 3, 3 dc in same space.

*Ch 1, 3 dc in next ch 1 space. Ch 1, (3 dc, ch 3, 3 dc) in next corner.

Repeat from * 4 more times.

Ch 1, 3 dc in next ch 1 space.

Ch 1, join with sl st to top of beginning ch 3.

Repeat pattern established in round 3 with a ch 1 between sets of 3dc except at corners where you ch 3 between sets of 3 dc until round 12. End off.



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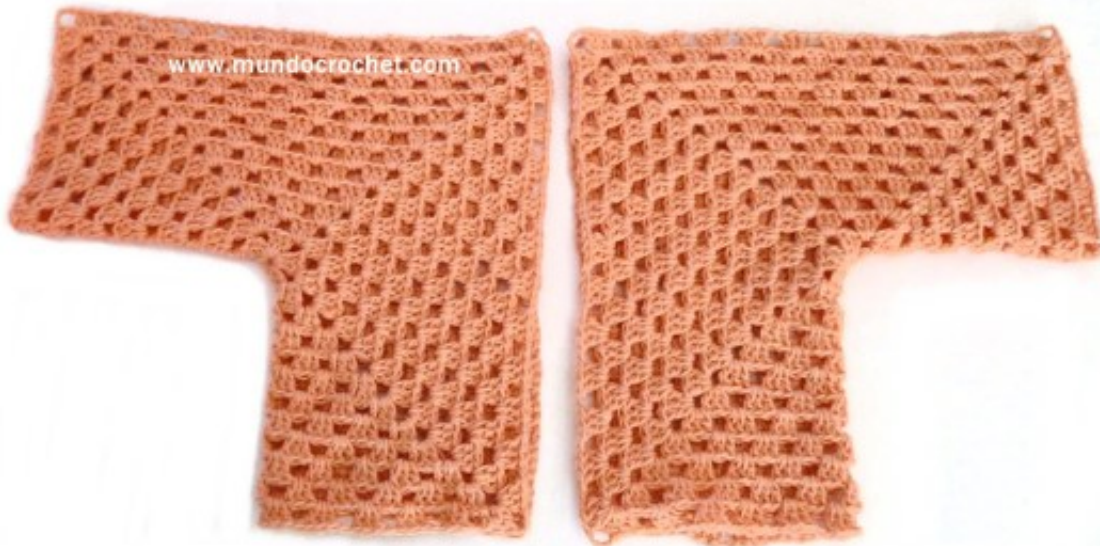

Fold the hexagon in half to form the 2 sides of the jacket.

Make a 2nd one. We will have the 2 halves of the jacket.



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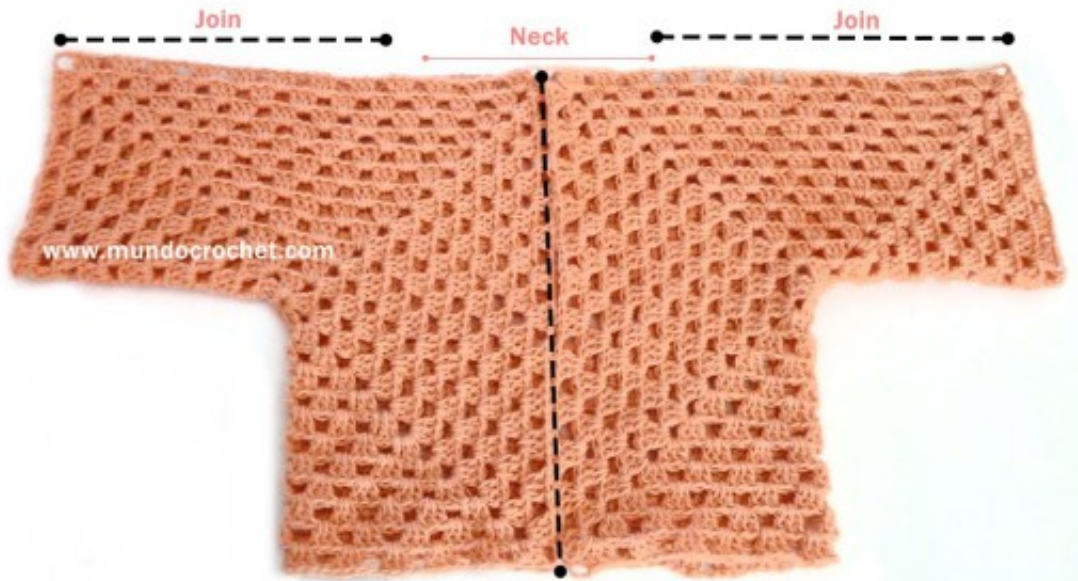

Back seam: join the 2 halves with 2 sc in the 3 ch space, *3 ch, 1 sc in ch 1 space.

Repeat from * across the back. Finish with 2 sc in the last ch 3 space.

Shoulders seam: from 3° ch 1 space from the front neck edge join in the same manner (sc, ch 3, sc).

Repeat across the shoulder of other side.



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(11) To make a longer jacket, make 2 more rows around the jacket following the pattern (3 dc in first ch 3 space, ch 1, 3 dc in each ch 1 space. Finish with 3 dc in the last ch 3 space).

Make 2 rows of sc around the border of the jacket (1 sc in each dc, except at corners where you make 3 sc). In the 1st row make the buttonholes as follows: 3 sc in ch 3 space, *ch 3, skip 3 dc, 3 sc in next 3 dc. Repeat from * 2 more times. Continue row with 1 sc in each dc, 3 sc in corners. Make the 2nd in the same way.

Cuffs: ch 3 (count as 1st dc), *skip 1 dc, dc in next dc. Repeat from * around cuff. sl st in top of ch 3.

Ch 3, make 1 dc front post stitch, then make 1 dc back post, repeat around cuff. Join in top of ch 3.

Repeat this row 3 more times (front posts into front posts, and back posts into back posts).

Repeat on opposite cuff.
