

Round yoke baby crochet cardigan: free pattern and tutorial

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Round yoke baby crochet cardigan



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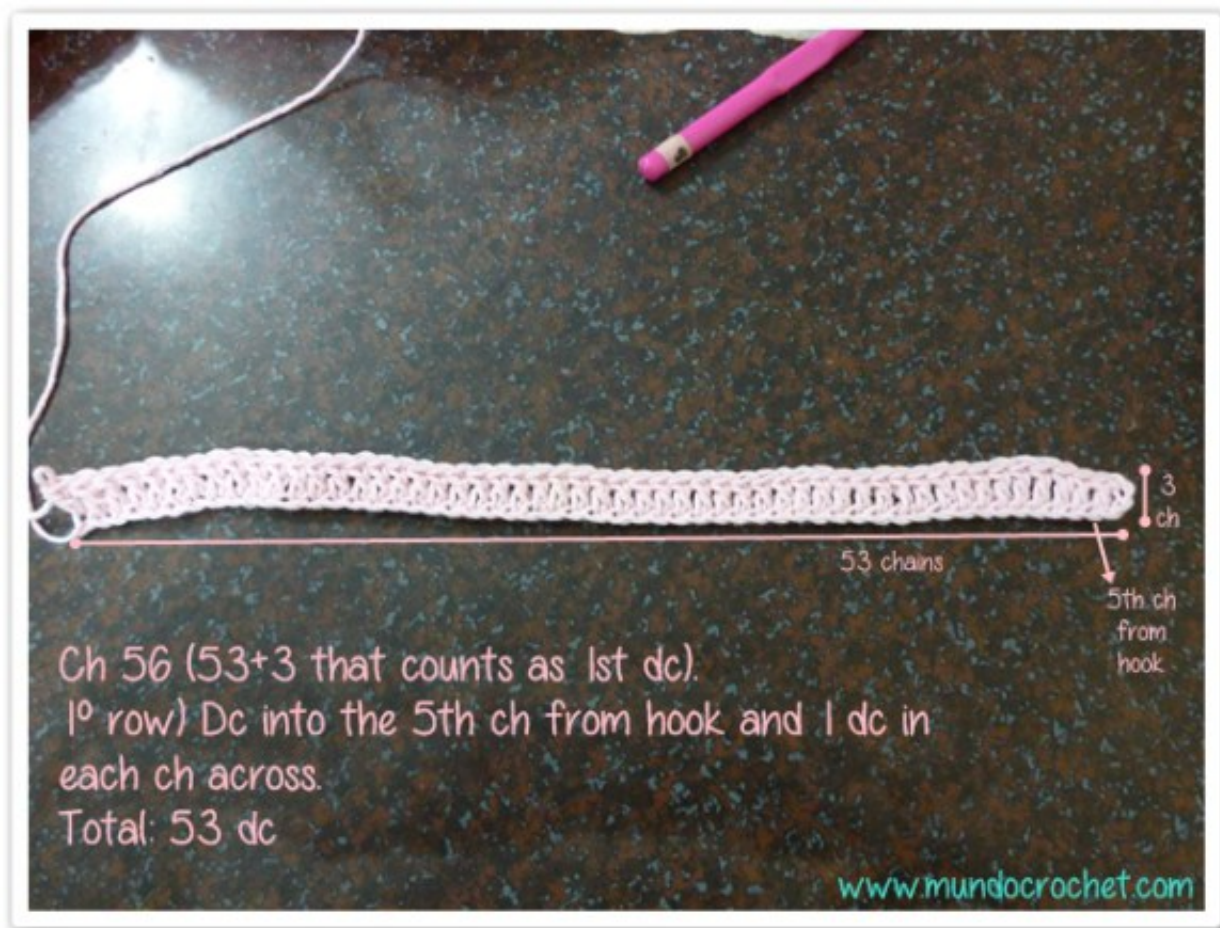
Today I want to show you this baby crochet cardigan that I made for my youngest daughter. I just loved this project. The round yoke gives it a feminine and original touch.

This is a very simple project once you learn how to crochet the yoke, especially when you have to divide it into fronts, back and sleeves. This step is similar to what we learned in the tutorial of the [little girl crochet cardigan](#), the only difference is that in this project I crocheted 2 dc instead of 1 into the joining stitches.

If you want to transform it into a sweater or jacket, you just have to continue crocheting 1 dc into each of the 26 stitches that we leave for the sleeves.

To increase the size, repeat rows 6 and 7 until you reach the desired size for the yoke. From there the rest of the steps are the same, only changes the number of stitches.

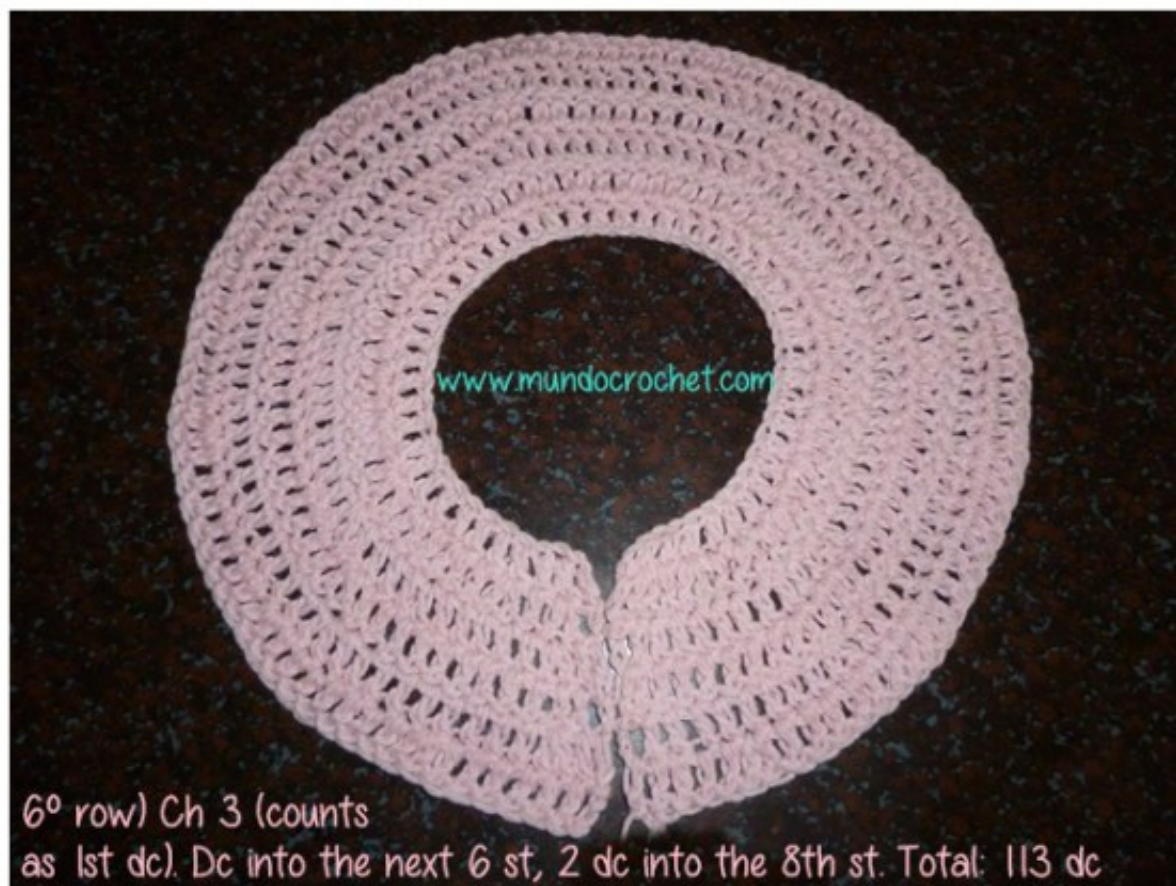






5º row) Ch 3 (counts as 1st dc). Dc into the next 8 st, 2 dc into the 10th st. Total: 101 dc







9^o row) Divide the yoke into fronts (19 dc), back (37 dc) and sleeves (26 dc).
Ch 3 (counts as 1st dc), dc into the next 17 st. Mark the 19th st, then skip the next 26 st for the sleeve. To make the dc for the beginning of the back, insert hook into both the 19th and the 46th st and finish working 2 dc into the same st as usual. Dc in the next 35 st. Mark the 82nd st, skip 26 st for the second sleeve, then make 2 dc for the beginning of the right front side by inserting the hook into the marked 82nd and the 109th st together and finish working 2 dc into the same st. Continue working dc across the front yoke stitches. (see next picture)





10^o row) Ch 3 (counts as 1st dc), skip the next st, (1 dc, ch 1, 1 dc) into 3rd st, *ch 1, skip 2 st (1 dc, ch 1, 1 dc) into the next st. Repeat from * until end 1 dc into the last st.

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11^o to 12^o) Ch 3 (counts as 1st dc), (1 dc, ch 1, 1 dc) into the ch 1 space of the previous row, *ch 1, (1 dc, ch 1, 1 dc) into next ch 1 space. Repeat from * until end To finish, 1 dc into the last st.

13^o row) Repeat row 12. Count 4 ch 1 spaces and crochet (1dc, ch1, 1dc), ch1, (1dc, ch1, 1dc) into the 5th space (increase). Repeat until end. 1 dc into the last st.

increase



14^o to 21^o rows) Repeat row 12.

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Here you can see the charted pattern:

Pattern:

Size: 3-6 months

Gauge:

15 stitches and 9 rows= 10x10cm

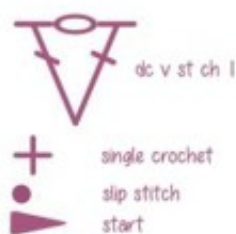
Materials:

*100 grs.of cotton yarn .

*US 7 / 4.5 mm crochet hook.

*3 buttons.

Measures:

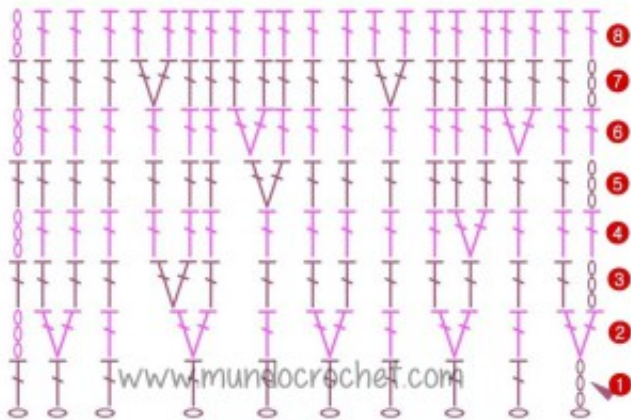

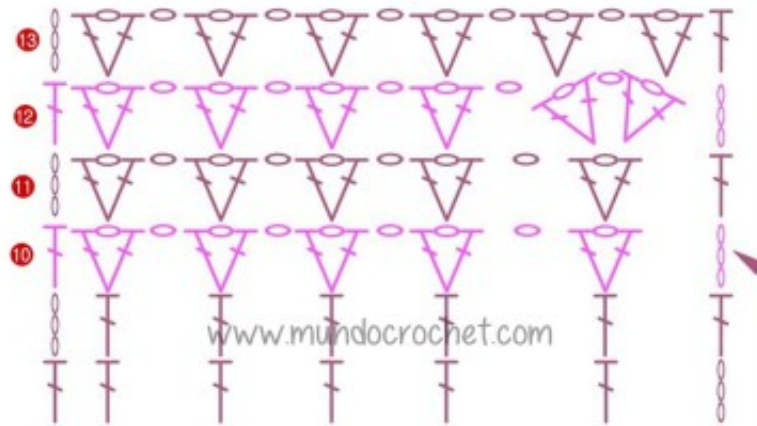
Yoke:



53 chains

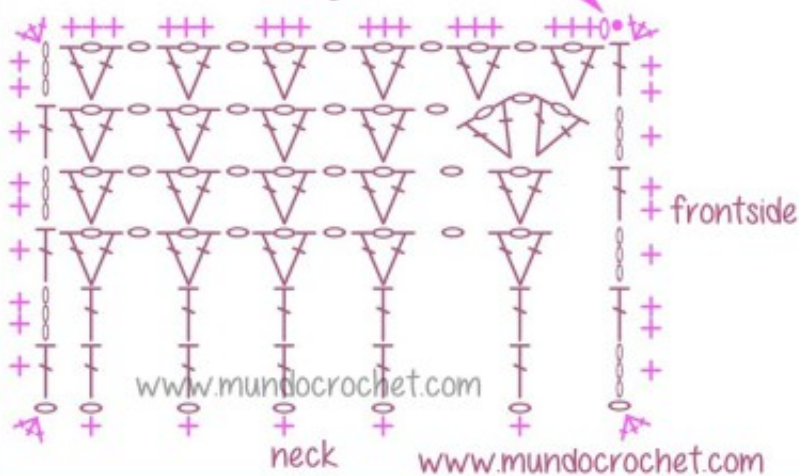
Row 9 divide yoke

Rows 14 to 21:
repeat row 12

Edge:



rows 10 to 21

rows 1 to 9
